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Therapy Program

Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services provides in home physical and occupational therapy to Florida children in need of such services. This rehabilitation is necessary to be rendered in the home because of the absence of these services locally, or because of the patient being medically infirmed at home. Priority is given to children who do not have ready access to therapy as a result of financial considerations.

The therapists who render services are employed by the Florida Elks consist of twenty (20) OTs or PTs licensed to practice by the State of Florida. Upon receiving the patient application or referral, the therapist will arrange a home visit for evaluation purposes. If the patient is accepted into the program, a regular weekly home visitation schedule is established. Parents are required to be present so they can carry out treatments between visits by the therapist.

As soon as the application is received, it will be reviewed in order to determine if the therapy program is appropriate for the patient's needs. The patient's family will be advised whether or not the patient is accepted into the program.
